

Group Mobile Instructions and Rubric

Knowledge: Demonstrate recognition and understanding of the literary terms studied.

Skills:

- Able to make a connection between the literary terms and examples of the terms in novel.
- Able to create a visual presentation that represents a given set of instructions.

Product Instructions:

1. Read a novel of your choice.
2. Each student must identify 3 DIFFERENT literary terms studied within the story (refer to pages 342-345 in *Write Source* book for more info): characterization, conflict, setting, plot, plotline, exposition, rising action, climax, resolution, theme, tone, point of view, protagonist, antagonist
3. Include the **term & definition** on your mobile.
4. For each term **choose a passage (4-6 lines)** from the story that identifies the element.
5. Create a mobile which identifies each term studied, and displays the corresponding quote for that term.
6. Include a **2-3 sentence explanation** describing how each passage clearly demonstrates each literary term. (DO NOT SAY: THIS PASSAGE/QUOTE SHOWS----)
7. Make sure you include the **title of the book, the author & your NAMES.**
8. You must also have **3 visuals** per person that represent images from the story, and enhance your mobile.
9. **YOU MAY NOT USE A HANGER. BE CREATIVE!**

RUBRIC

90-100: This mobile will not be suspended by a hanger. Each literary term (6 for 2 people & 9 for 3 people) will be clearly represented and defined correctly. Each term has a clear, well-written explanation demonstrating how each passage represents the literary term. There will be 3 visuals per person from the story to complement the mobile. The overall product will be neat, will show time and effort, and will be complete. This product will also show a creative and unique approach to the assignment.

80-90: This mobile will not be suspended by a hanger. Each literary term will be clearly represented and defined correctly. The explanation of each term is vague and does not demonstrate clear understanding. There will be a passage of 4-6 lines from the story that represents each term. There will be at least 3 visuals from the story to compliment the mobile. The overall product will be neat, will show time and effort and be complete.

70-80: To show competency on this assignment you must meet the minimum requirements which include: no hanger, each term identified and defined, and visuals from the story. What identifies a "C" may include a lack of care with correctly defining the terms, choosing short passages, and not demonstrating any time or effort with the product.
