

Set or Costume Design

Chose between set or costume design -

Set/Scene Design

1. Each person must create **a set plan with either detailed black and white or colored sketches or 3-D models** (such as a diorama) of the setting in a medium of your choice. (Total of 3 scenes or settings.)
2. **All materials must be labeled with: The Title and Author of the Novel, Chapter or chapters in which the set is used, and your name.**
3. Each person must also include a **1 page statement** discussing your design choices including descriptions of the character(s) for whom you designed the set including:
 1. **2 quotes** from your novel
 2. A summary of the scene(s) in which the set will be used
 3. A discussion of your color and design choices. Are the designs going to be whimsical? Will it be realistic? Will it be historically accurate? Will the colors used be bright, pastel, or dark?
 4. Make sure you state why you chose the designs with reference to the novel's **setting, theme and time period.**

4. **Grading Rubric**

Costume Design

1. **Two pictures of costumes per person.** These may be taken from the Internet, magazines or you may draw or paint your own costume designs. (Each of you must design 2 costumes for different characters in your book).
2. **A 1-1.5 page statement** of your costume design choices. If you draw or paint your own costumes then you must write a 1-page statement. If you cut out or obtain an image from the Internet, you must write a 1.5 -page statement. These statements must include
 1. Descriptions of the character(s) for whom you designed the costumes
 2. Include **2 quotes** from your novel
 3. A summary of the scene(s) in which the costumes will be used

4. A discussion of your color and style choices. Are the designs going to be whimsical? Will it be realistic? Will it be historically accurate? Will the colors used be bright, pastel, or dark? Make sure you state why you chose the designs with reference to the novel's **setting, theme and time period**.
